Introduction

Bedford Disabled Horse Riding Association celebrates its 65th birthday this year and to mark the occasion what better way than to go the 'extra mile' with a run or walk taking you through 7.2 miles of Bedfordshire countryside starting and finishing at our riding centre on Balls Lane in Willington.

Together with our friends at The Rotary Club of Bedford Park, we have created this wonderful opportunity to get fit and to raise funds for a very worthwhile cause.

The Rotary Club is no stranger to arranging running and walking challenges and this event will also be an opportunity to remember Martyn Pearson, a stalwart organiser behind their previous challenges, who sadly passed away in December 2025. Martyn's wife Lorrie is set to send us all on our way.



The plan is for entrants to either **Run** or **Walk** the **10k + 1 mile** (see what we did there?) on **Saturday 24th October 2026**.

Participants

The runs and walks are open to anyone, although there is a minimum age of 16 for runners. You can even take part 'virtually' and still get sponsored. It is recommended that each entrant carries out some form of training prior to the event to make sure that they are fit enough to complete the course. All participants enter at their own risk. Marshalls will direct you around the course, please pay attention to any directions that they may give you.

Sponsorship

As this is a Charity Fund Raising Event for Bedford Disabled Horse Riding Association, all entrants are encouraged to raise as much money as they can through sponsorship. Minimum recommended sponsorship is £100.

Start Time

The walk will commence at 9.00 a.m. with the run starting at 10.15 a.m. The walks are expected to take circa two and a half hours to complete whilst the runs are estimated to take circa an hour to an hour and a half. Times are of course dependent on the speed/fitness of the entrants. Please arrive at least thirty minutes prior to the start time of your chosen event.

Facilities

There is plenty of parking on site together with both normal and accessible WCs. We have a large indoor arena to shelter from the rain should that prove necessary. Refreshments will be served.

Route

The route for the event will start from The Riding Centre in Balls Lane, Willington and take in The Dane Camp and Bedford's Priory Marina along the way. A copy of the route is attached.

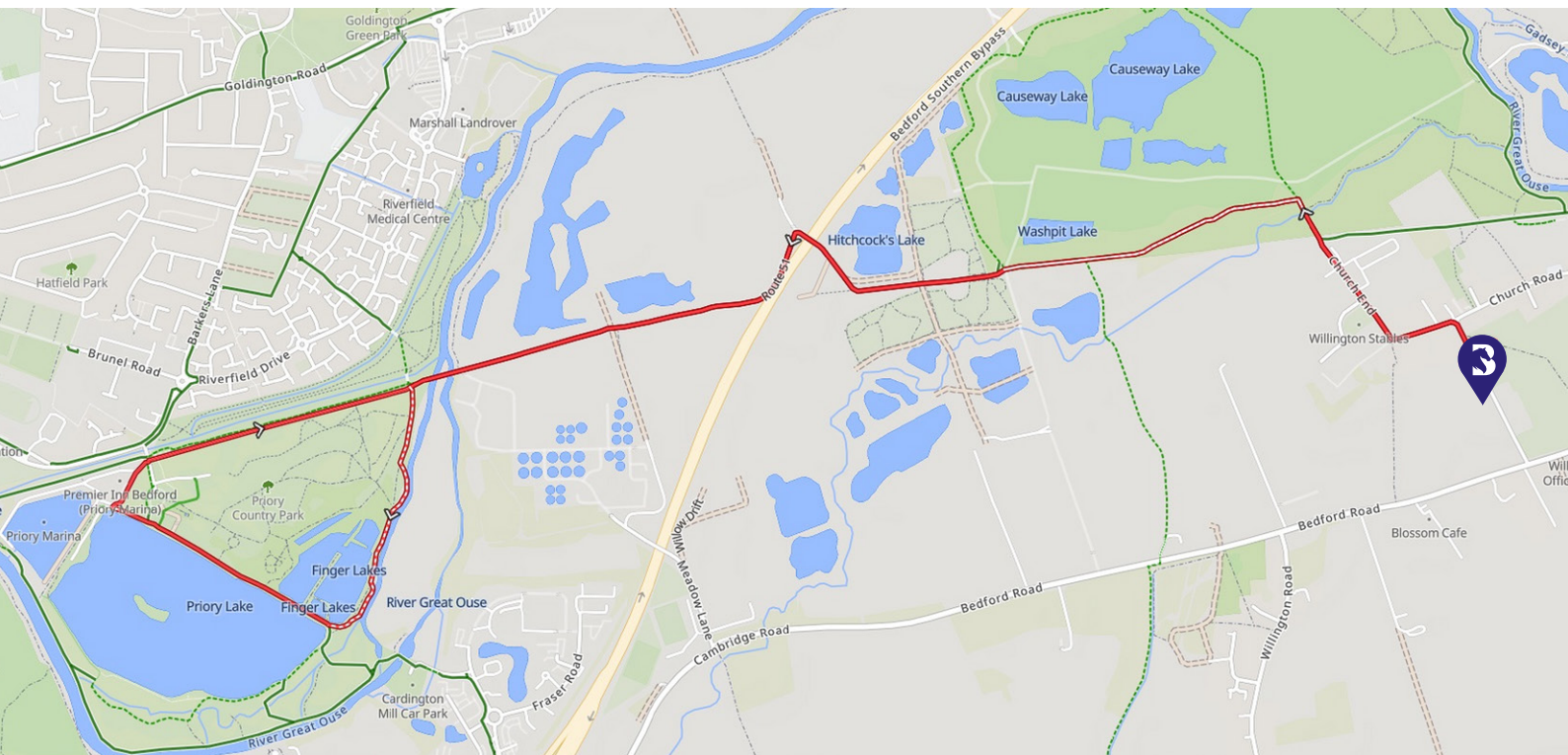
